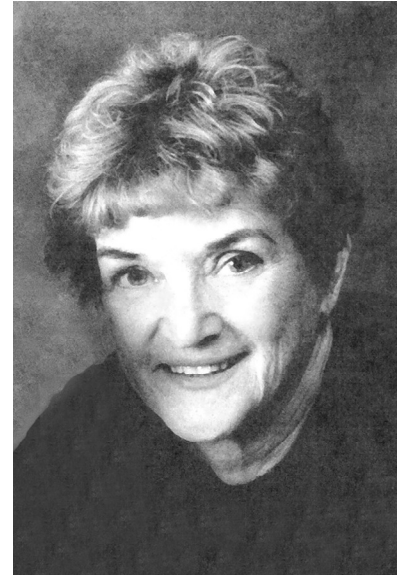

**Contributions and Personal Accomplishments to the Breed:** I developed this Judges Book when I served on the BCA Guidelines Committee during my term as a BCA Councilor for Division I. With my late husband, Ernie Hubbard, I held countless informal, educational gathering at our home using multi-media devices, such as videos, charts, audio and visual aids, over-head projections as well as live animals. In addition, I have been a resource for novice and experienced Bulldoggers on health issues and have always been available to French *Bulldog* and Bulldog owners across the land.

I attended my first BCA National in Charlotte, N.C. in 1979, with puppies from my very first litter. Three of these puppies placed everyday in Sweeps, and one of them, Londonderry Skin-a-Kin, was WD and BOW at the companion show to the National, and he went on to be the first of my more than 35 Champions. Many of my home bred Champions were under the name of Londonderry which was prior to my becoming a partner with Brookhol-

low. I have Bulldog Dam and sire that are in the BCA Hall of Fame for producing Champion get. Ernie and I organized the very first bus trip to a BCA National Show. We had 23 dogs and 21 humans on the trip to NC. This event was immortalized in the AKC Gazette.

I have been privileged to judge Bulldogs at the International Show in France. I have judged the French Bulldog National Show in Japan three times, and I have been invited back to judge the show in March of 2008.

But most of all, I am proud that during my 30 plus years in bulldogs, I have introduced so many delightful people to the wonderful Bulldog family and helped them continue our BCA tradition.
