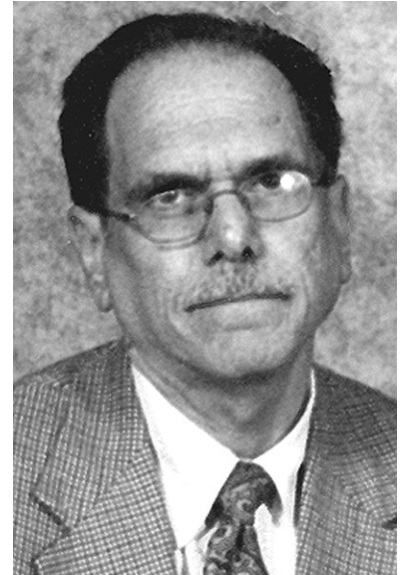

Contributions and Personal Accomplishments to the Breed:

With my wife Dorothy, we bred our first litter in 1989 and have finished 39 champions, including 32 we have bred, placing us on the 1st plateau in the Hall of Fame as breeders. Four of our dogs are Hall of Fame Top Producers. The majority of our dogs have finished with specialty majors and have produced a consistent type with sound health and joyful temperaments.

Education is crucial to the breed at every level. As an approved BCA mentor, I have conducted hands on workshops on the standard at the club level, mentored many breeders, and mentored prospective judges at the National Show, local specialties and at our kennel. I have taught handling classes for bulldoggers and all-breed handlers. We both love seeing people we have mentored breed and show their dogs to specialty wins and are proud to see judges we have mentored find the specialty winning dogs in large entries.

I have lectured to specialty and all-breed dog clubs regarding various topics on dogs and the law and serve on the Governor's Dog Law Advisory Board for Pennsylvania. Before retiring, I was the General Counsel and Acting Executive Director of one of the largest municipal shelter systems in America and ensured that breed rescue groups had the opportunity to rehome dogs in the shelter system.
